- Clean and repair drains, waste, and sewer pipes. E
- Repair, replace, and adjust domestic hot water systems. E
- Conduct swimming pool maintenance related to workscope. E
- Complete work assignments from plans, oral and written instructions, sketches and drawings. E
- Work with all District employees, architecture and engineering employees, and outside contractors. E
- Oversee assigned personnel. E
- Perform related duties as assigned.

Any combination of education, training and/or experience equivalent to: graduation from high school and two years of journey-level plumbing experience.
