2024 SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE NORTHERN CALIFORNIA PIPE TRADES HEALTH AND WELFARE PLAN ("PLAN")

This is a summary of the Annual Report of the Northern California Pipe Trades Health and Welfare Plan, EIN 94-3183274, Plan No. 501, for the period July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024. The Annual Report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration ("EBSA"), as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 ("ERISA").

The Board of Trustees of the Northern California Pipe Trades Health and Welfare Trust Funds has committed itself to pay certain qualifying medial benefit expenses under a health reimbursement arrangement.

INSURANCE INFORMATION

The plan has contracts with Blue Shield of California, Delta Dental of California, Kaiser Foundation Health Plan Inc., Principal Life Insurance Company and Vision Service Plan to pay certain medical, dental, vision and life insurance benefits under the terms of the Plan. The total premiums paid for the Plan Year ending June 30, 2024, were \$77,679,295.

BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The value of Plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the Plan, was \$141,241,408 as of June 30, 2024, compared to \$127,430,893 as of July 1, 2023. During the Plan year, the Plan experienced an increase in its new assets of \$13,810,515. This increase includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of Plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the Plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. During the Plan year, the Plan had total income of \$96,786,472, including employer contributions of \$85,312,801, employee contributions of \$2,322,261, earnings from investments of \$9,068,095, and other income of \$83,315.

Plan expenses were \$82,975,957. These expenses included \$2,729,577 in administrative expenses, and \$80,246,380 in benefits paid to Participants and Beneficiaries.

If you request a copy of the full Annual Report from the Plan Administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the Annual Report at the Trust Fund Office, or at the U.S. Department of Labor in Washington D.C., or obtain a copy from the U.S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
